HOW MANY WHALES?

Play with the whales to teach your toddler early number skills. Count out loud the number of dots on each whale. Help him trace the numeral with his finger, then trace it in the air.

NUMBER MATCH

Help your toddler count the number of dots on a big whale. Then let him find the matching numeral on a small whale. Place the small whale on the big whale's tale.

WHAT COMES NEXT?

Place the whales on the floor and help your toddler count out loud from 1-5 as he puts the whales in sequential order.

BALANCING ACT

Balancing can be fun! Help your toddler balance the baby whale on top of the mommy whale. Nest the small whale inside the big one.
