

CHUNKY PEGGY



Colorful large pegs that are easy for babies to hold in their hands or even on their tiny fingers.

Fit them together, build them high on the board, or simply clang them together.

TALL TOWERS

Place the pegs on top of each other, counting as you go. See how tall you can make the tower before it topples over. Build it again and let your baby swipe it down - laughter will ensue.

PATTERN TIME

Create different patterns using the colored pegs and pegboard. Help your toddler copy the pattern to match yours. Name the colors as you go.

MUSIC TIME

Sitting with your baby with two pegs for each of you, bang the pegs together. "Clang, Clang, Bang, Bang." Bang them softly, then try it loudly. Try it fast, try it slow.

REACH ACROSS

Place a few pegs just out of your baby's reach. Encourage him to reach for the peg and then place it on the board. Can you see him use a dominant hand? Is he crossing midline?
