

SHAPE SORTING CUBE



This shape sorter features chunky shapes that make a satisfying 'clink' as they drop into the hardwood cube! Your child's favorite part - open the lid, dump them out, and start all over again! Each shape fits through a hole of the same shape on the wooden cube.

DEVELOPMENTAL AREAS

COLORS & SHAPES

Dump all the shape blocks on the floor. As you and your toddler play with the blocks, share the *shape names* and *colors*. Sort the blocks by color. Look around the room and find matching shapes.

PROBLEM-SOLVING

Where does this shape fit?
Start with some of the simpler shapes or the shapes on top. Play with your toddler to turn the block so it fits easily into the right opening.

BUILDING PATTERNS

Use the different colored shapes to build a tower with different patterns: start with just two colors, then try adding a third and finally all four colors. How many different patterns can you build?

HOW MANY SIDES?

Find the blocks that have sides. Find the blocks that have no sides. Sort the blocks into piles: "Sides" and "No Sides". How many are there of each?
