GUESS THE ANIMAL

When your baby picks up a block, name the animal on the block. Then make the sound of the animal.

Watch as your baby looks at the animal and listen as he tries to imitate the sound.

SQUEEZE ME

Pick up a block and gently squeeze it. Hand a block to your baby and watch him do the same.

How does it feel? "This feels squishy." What do you hear? "I heard a squeak."

TEETHING, TASTING

Infants learn about their world through their senses. Your baby will discover how the blocks feel on their gums, how the blocks taste when they chew on them.

Easy to wipe clean when you're done.

TOWERING FUN

Place the blocks on the rug or playmat in front of your baby and show him how to stack 2-3 blocks. Hand him a block to place on top. Encourage him to reach for another block and add to the tower.
