# **Referral Process**

Early Intervention (birth - age 3)

#### INITIATION OF ELIGIBILITY PROCESS

- Written referral may originate from teacher, family, or clinician
- If educator is referring party, preliminary communication with family/guardian is recommended
- Family/guardian consent required for evaluation process to begin

#### **EVALUATION PROCESS**

### Within 45 days of referral, Early Intervention Services must:

- Conduct assessments
- Determine eligibility
- If found eligible, schedule Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) meeting
- Develop an IFSP and receive consent from family/guardian

### **EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES**

- Services required to begin within 30 days of signed IFSP
- IFSP to be reviewed and updated at least every six months
- Services may include Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Physical Therapy, or Developmental Services

## TRANSITION TO NEXT PHASE

- Family Service Coordinator schedules Transition Conference
- Outcomes could include:
  - Services no longer required
  - Transition to private services
  - Transition to public services

# **Clarifying Service Pathways**

#### **MEDICAL**

Age: Any age

Fee Structure: Insurance or out-of-pocket

Eligibility Authority: Formal diagnosis (doctor or clinician)

Process: Diagnosis guides treatment

**Setting:** Services typically provided in a clinical setting **Context:** Children may qualify for medical support, but not

Early Intervention or school-based services.

#### **EARLY INTERVENTION**

Age: Birth - age 3

Fee Structure: Low-cost sliding scale

Eligibility Authority: Service coordinator provides guidance

Eligibility Details: Some children eligible at birth or shortly after

Setting: Services typically provided in a home or childcare

Context: Family centered

## **PUBLIC SCHOOL**

Age: Age 3 - school age (varies by state)

Fee Structure: No cost to family

Eligibility Authority: IEP team determines eligibility

Eligibility Details: Qualification dependent on educational impact

**Setting:** Services provided in least restrictive environment (LRE)

Context: Child centered
